Base Licenses

Add-On Licenses

These licenses are additional features or services from Microsoft that aren't tied to every user and can be purchased as needed. Here are a few examples: **Project**, **Copilot**, **Power BI**, **Power Automate**, **Visio Online Plan 2**.

Quick Tips

- You can upgrade or add licenses any time, but you can only remove licenses at your renewal date.
- Regularly check your accounts to identify licenses tied to inactive users, shared inboxes, or alias accounts. Remove or reassign these to avoid unnecessary charges.
- Even if a user leaves your organization, Microsoft continues billing for the license until your renewal date.
